COASTGUARDS at Wick decided today to call off a big hunt for a ship in the Outer Hebrides which was thought to have sent out an SOS during the night.

The controller of the RAF Northern Rescue Centre at Pitreavie Castle, Fife, said: "We understand the coastguards at Wick and Stornoway are treating the incident as a hoax."

The distress started when Stornoway coastguard picked up a message "Ship sinking" at 11.15 p.m. The message was received from a ship in the Outer Hebrides. The ship was thought to be in danger. 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University's crash plan to raise intake of students
